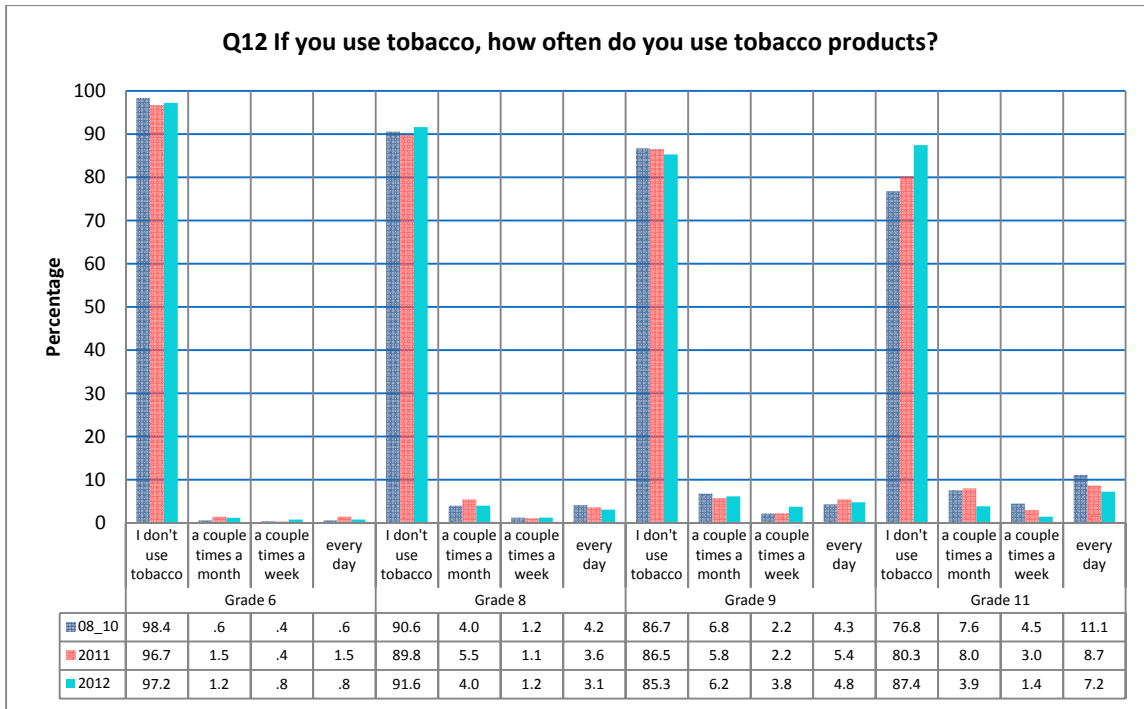

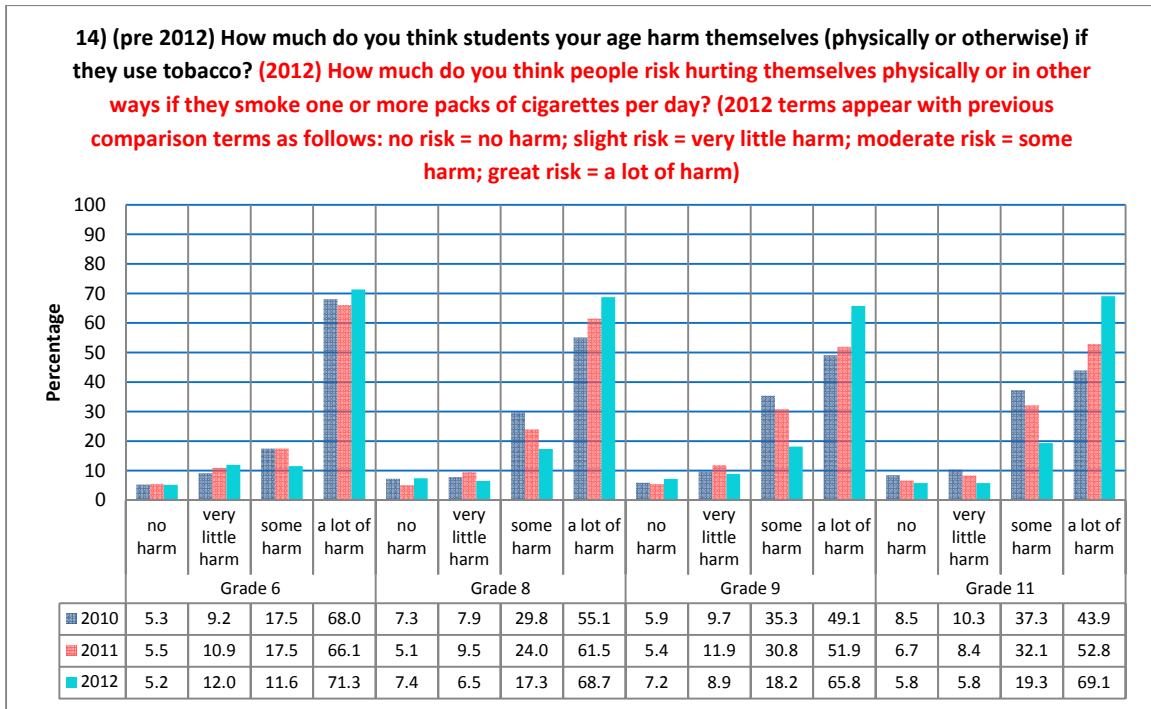

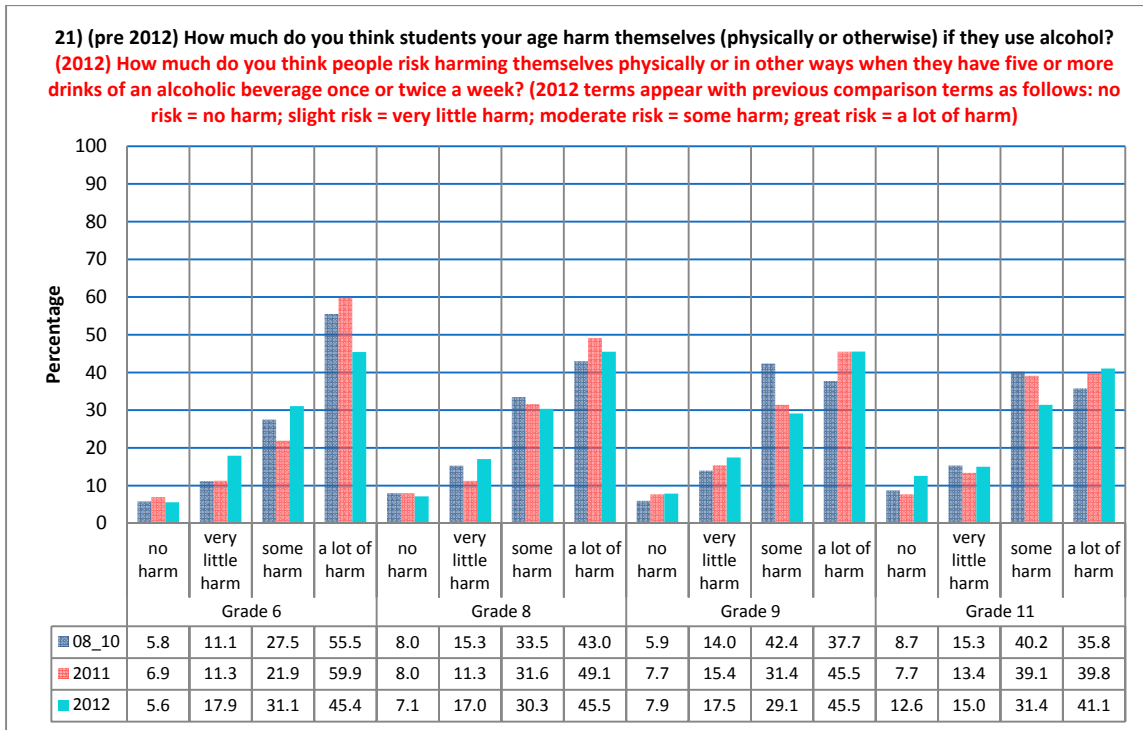

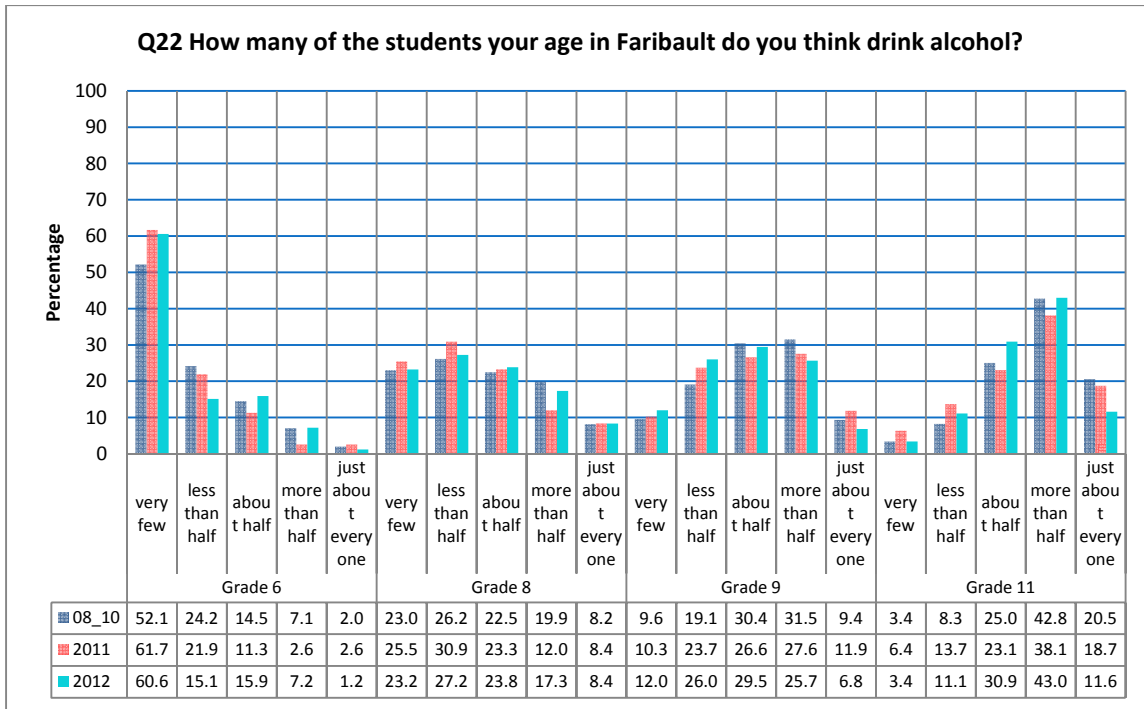

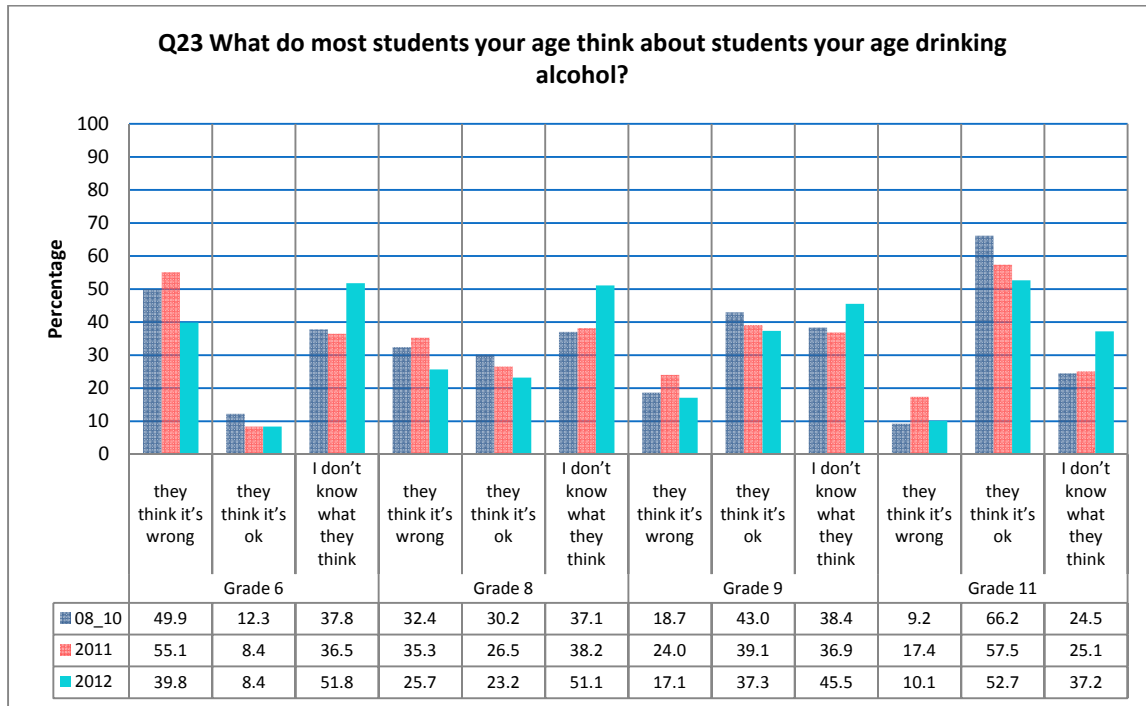

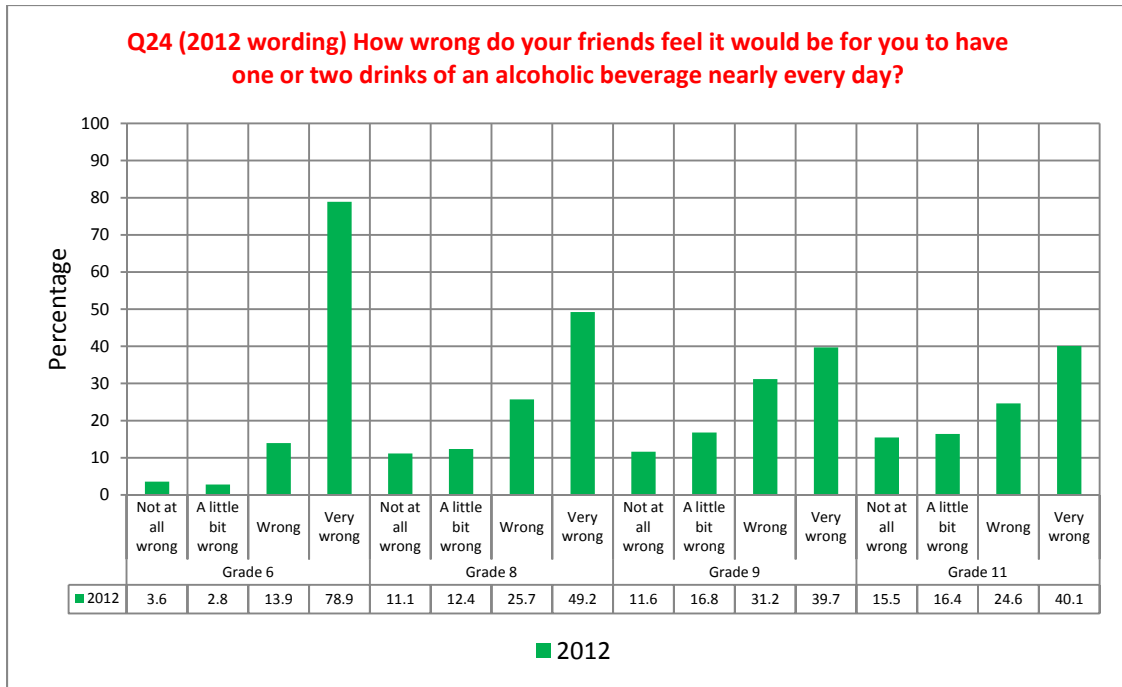

Note: Item Q23 (pre 2012) and item 24 (2012 and later) have similar research objectives but considerably different word structures. To show how the responses were combined to provide a common reporting procedure for these items, the graph and table below show the responses from both the original pre 2012 worded item (Q23, p. 17), and the newly mandated wording from the 2012 item (Q24, p. 18) merged together on p. 19. Only the alcohol section included both item versions in the 2012 survey, but this merging procedure is also used for similar items, and in the SAMHSA reporting section found later in the FSS 2012 Report. This merging process was used to provide a tracking bridge from previously collected data to the current system.



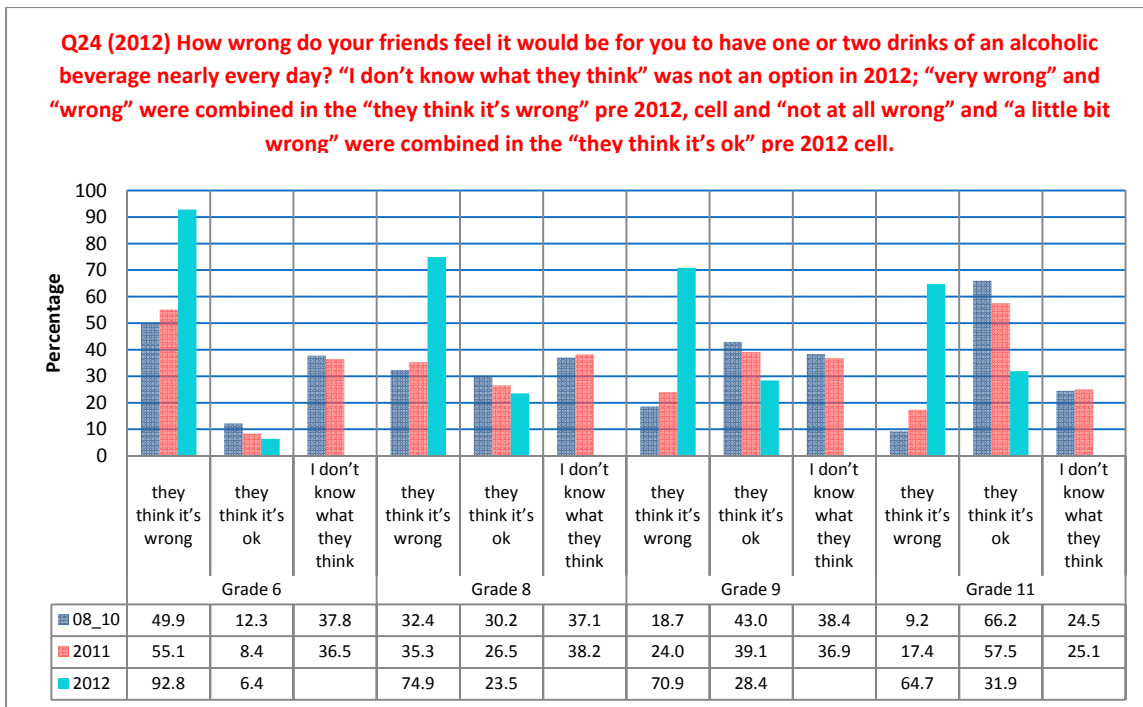

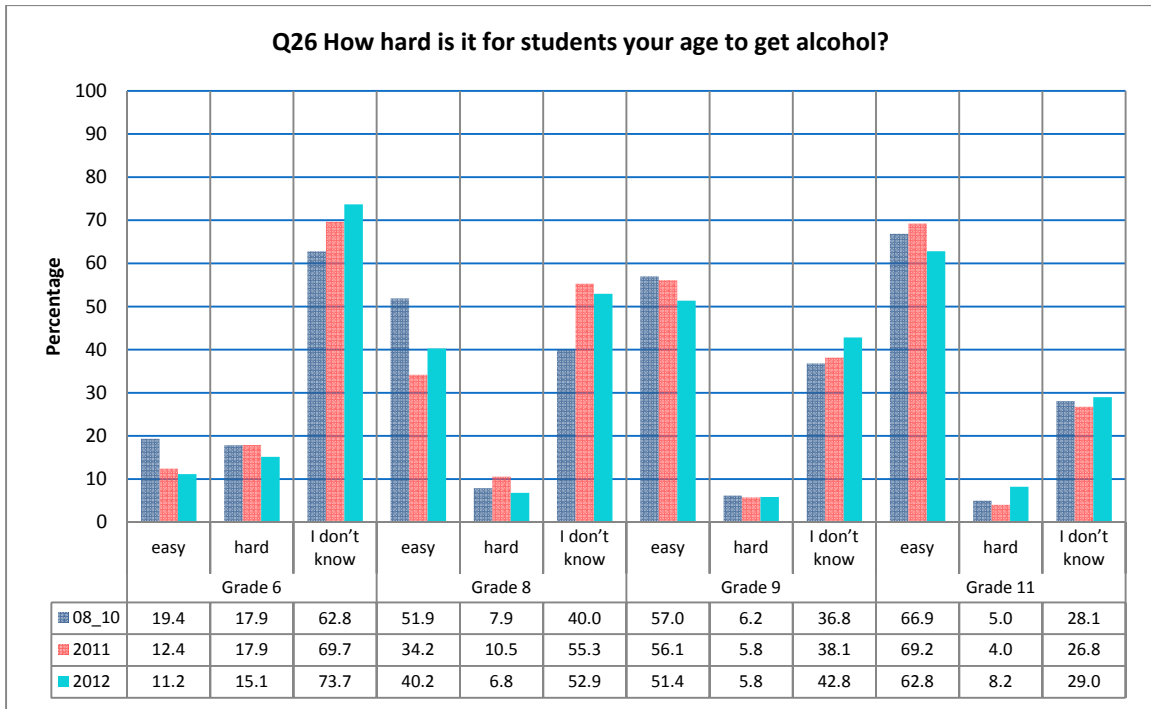

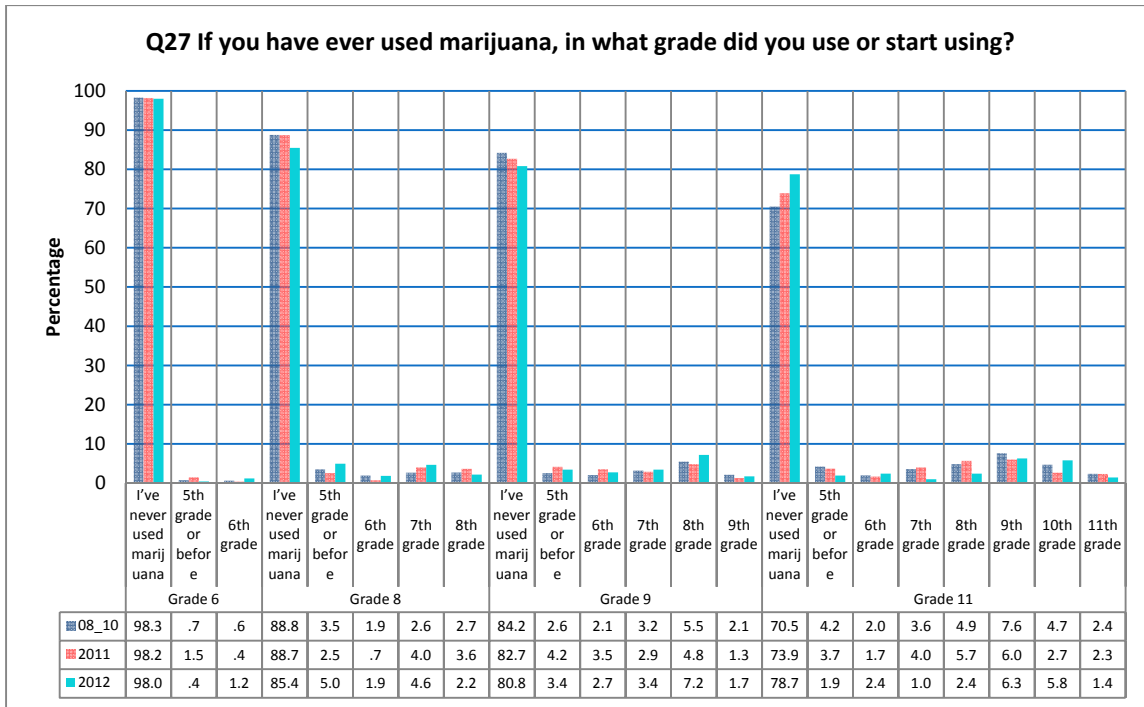

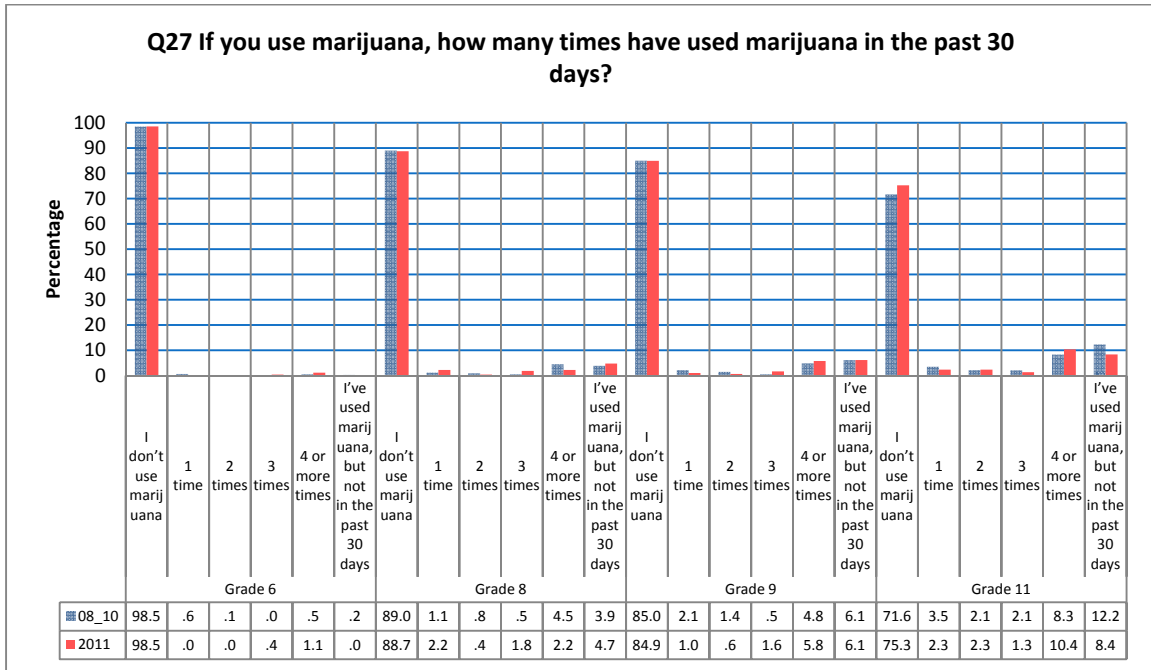

SAMHSA (Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration) a division of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, has developed uniform, nation-wide reporting guidelines and formulas. The following tables and charts show the FSS data from 2009 through 2012 in the original SAMHSA format. As of January 2012, SAMHSA reporting requirements no longer asked for substance use age of onset, but added un-prescribed prescription drug use and perceptions of peer disapproval of each of the substance categories. The new reporting requirements appear in a table on page 61. For references and comparisons, the FSS 2012 Report will incorporate both the former and current SAMHSA formats; however, word changes in some of the items used for reporting may have an effect on the numbers reported in 2012 compared to previous years. 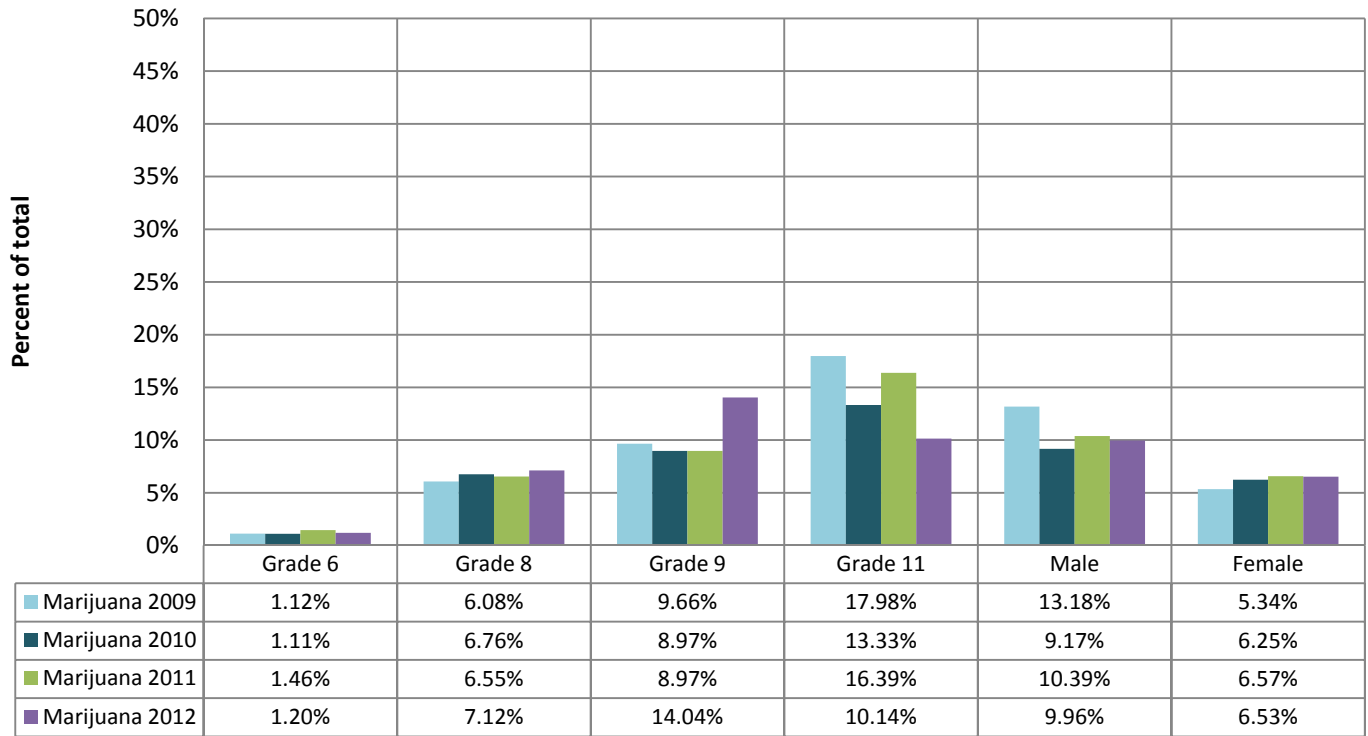

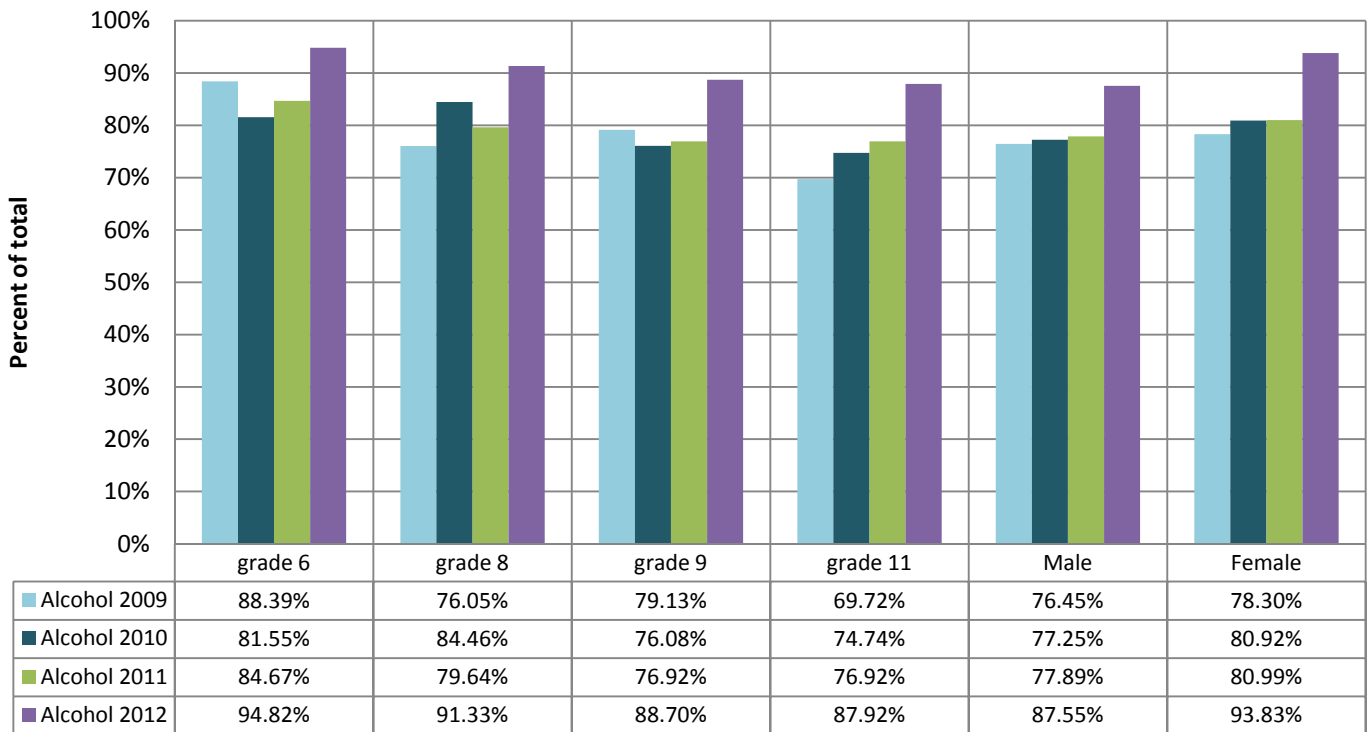
(SAMHSA FSS History by Required Reporting Variables)



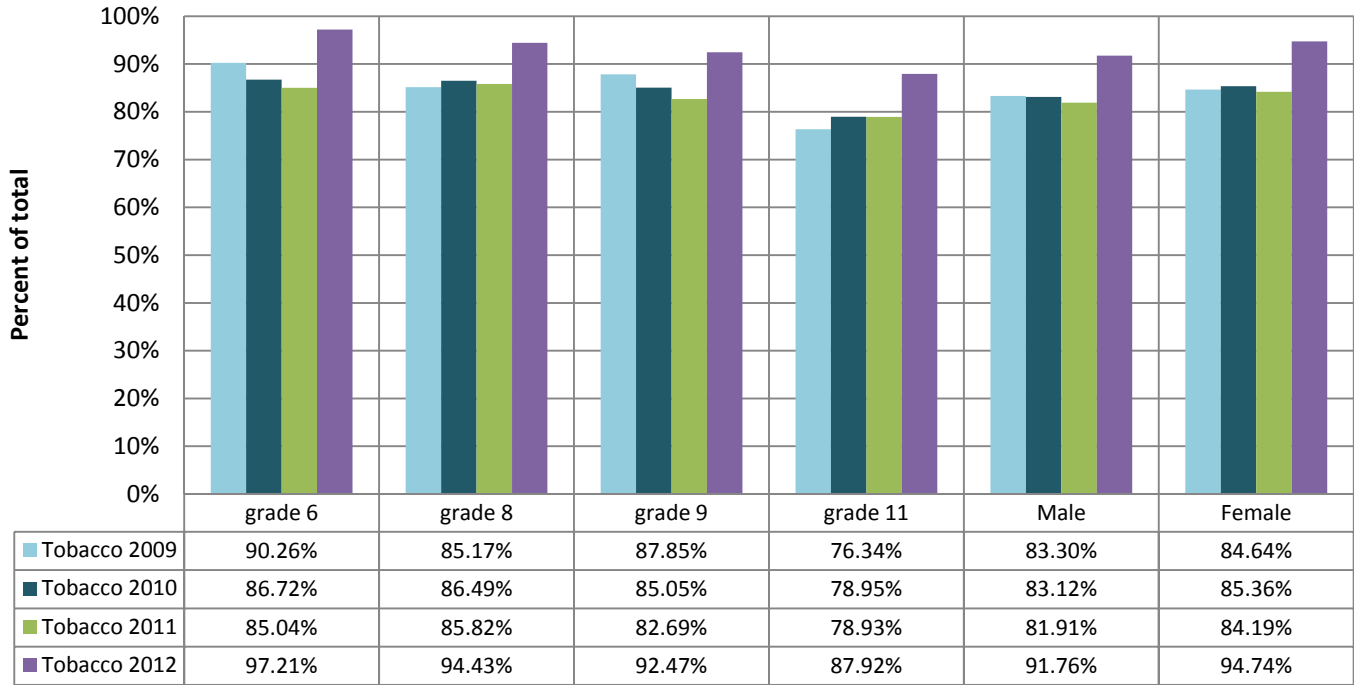
FSS Marijuana usage within the past 30 days, Gr. 6,8,9,11 SAMHSA Reporting 2009-2012



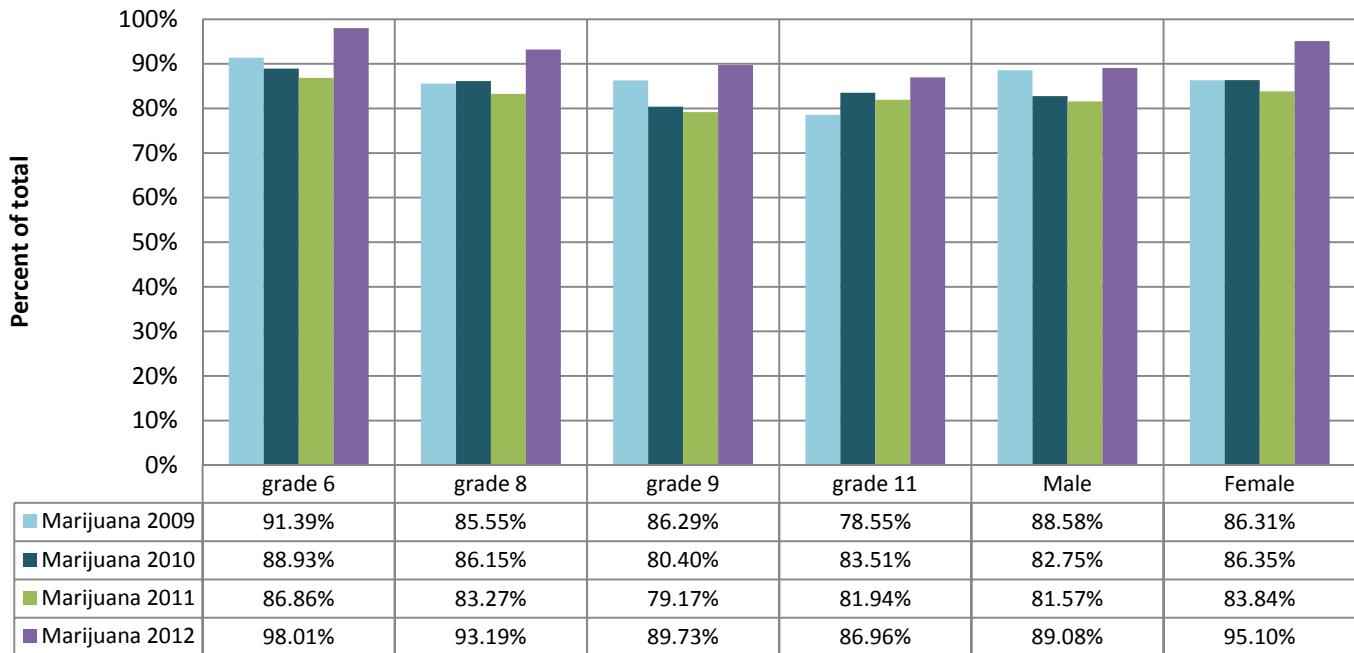
FSS Perception of Parental Disapproval, Alcohol, Gr. 6,8,9,11 SAMHSA Reporting 2009-2012



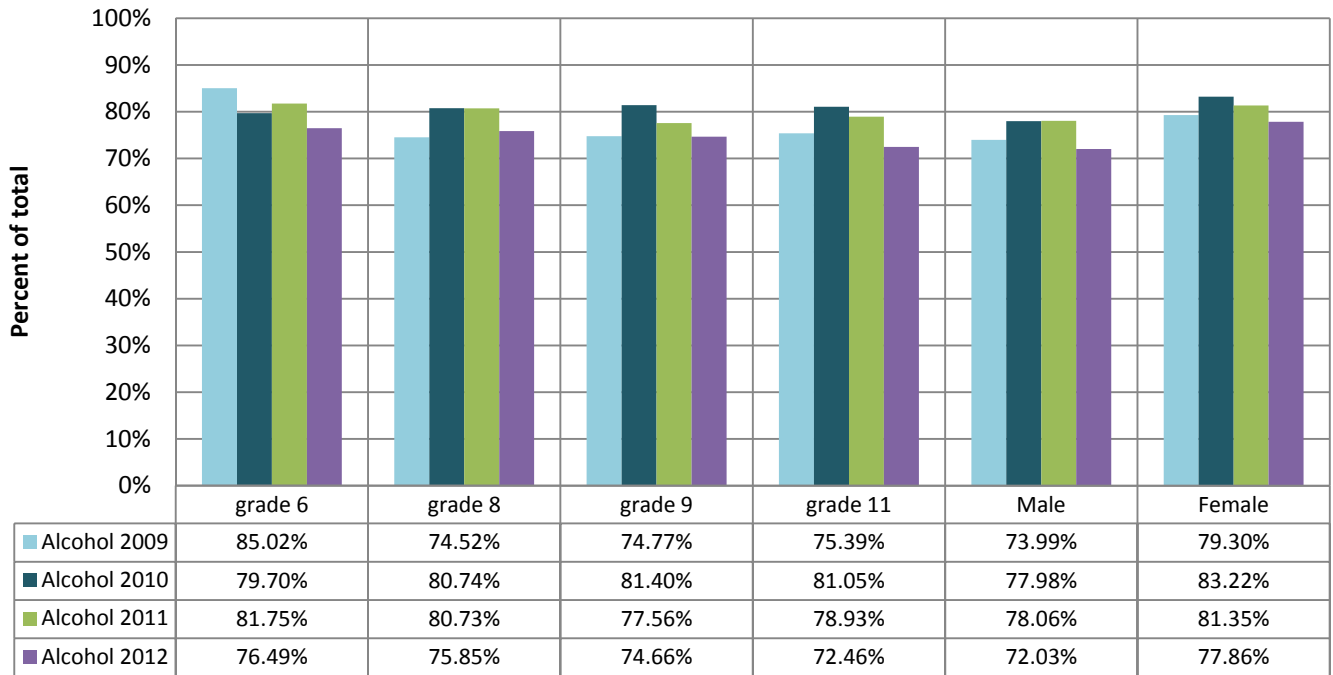
FSS Perception of Parental Disapproval, Tobacco, Gr. 6,8,9,11 SAMHSA Reporting 2009-2012



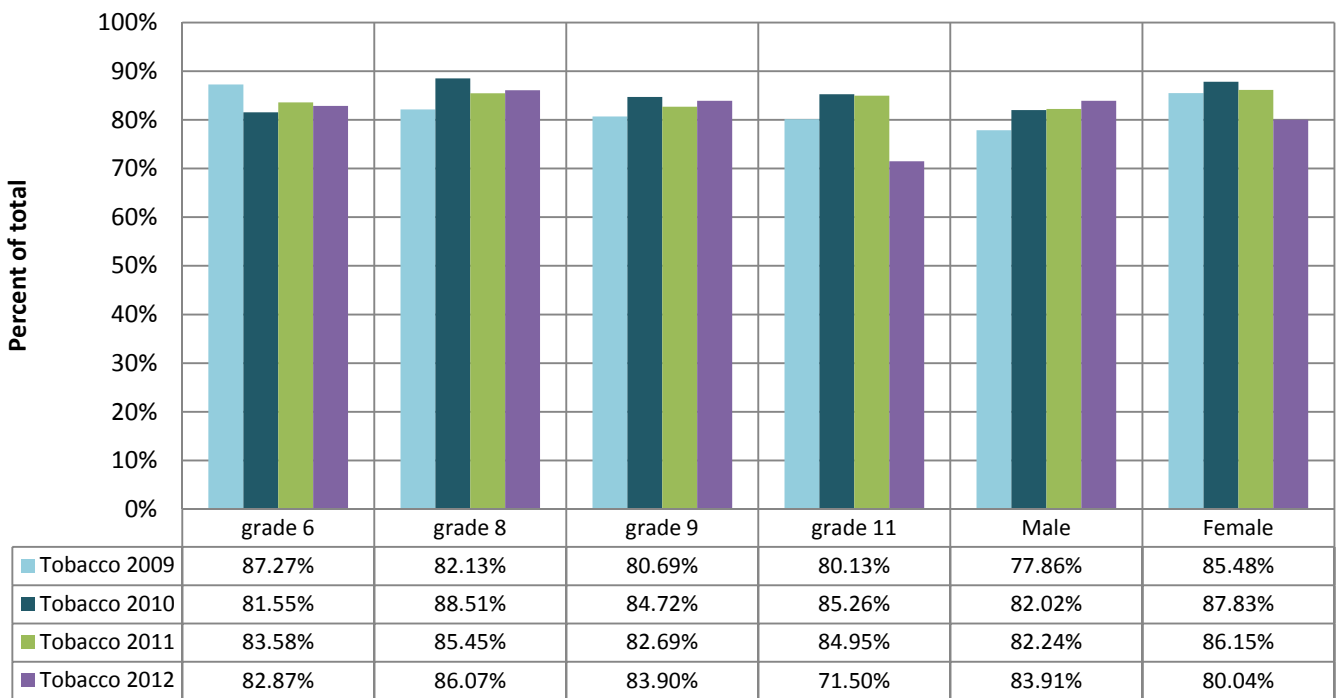
FSS Perception of Parental Disapproval, Marijuana, Gr. 6,8,9, 11: SAMHSA Reporting 2009-2012

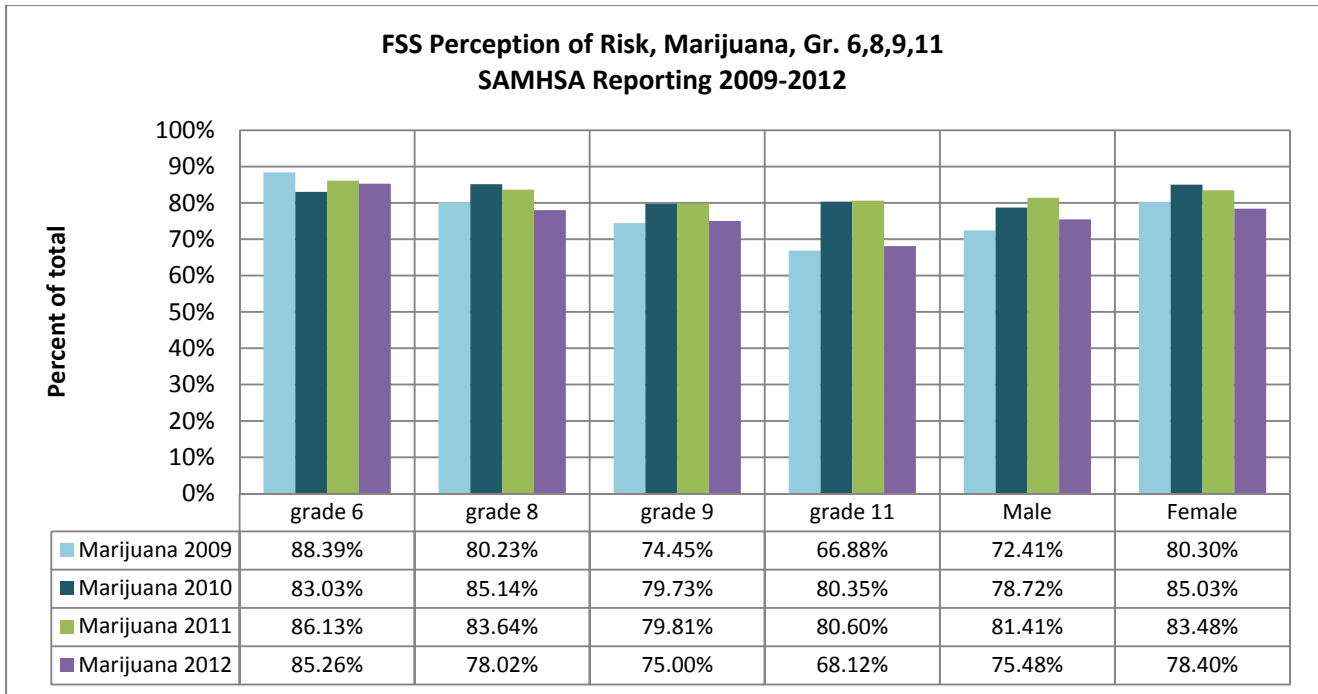


**FSS Perception of Risk, Alcohol, Gr. 6,8,9,11

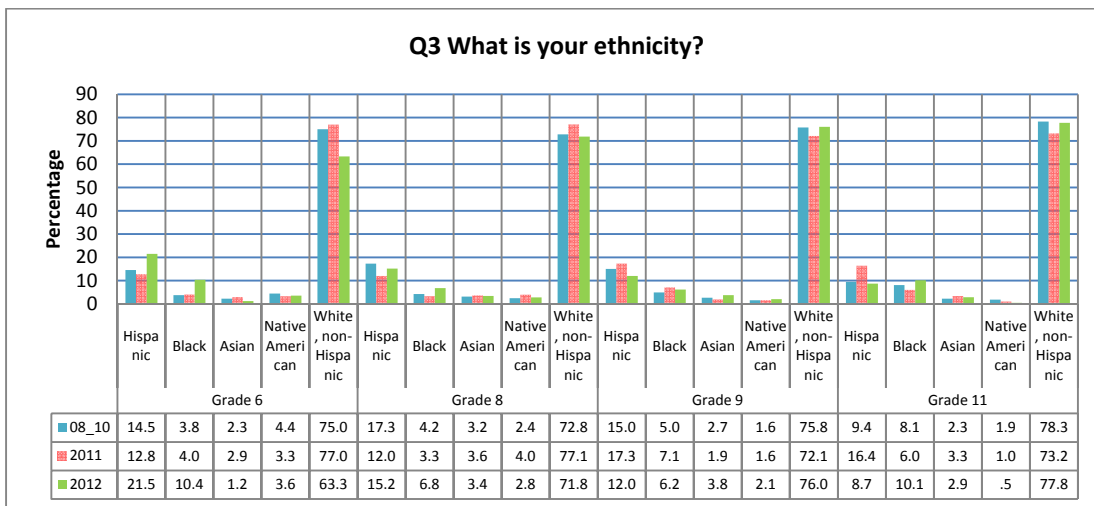
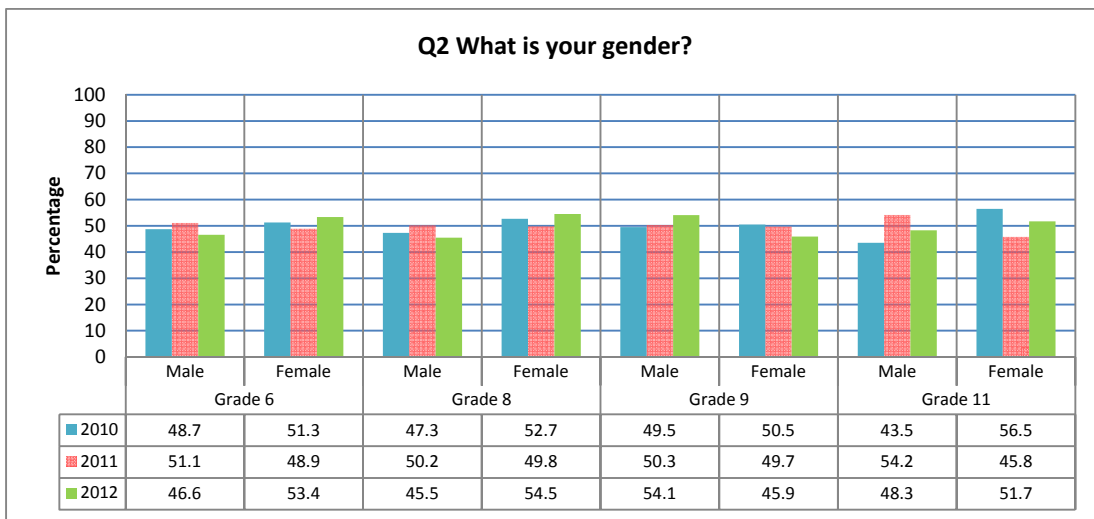
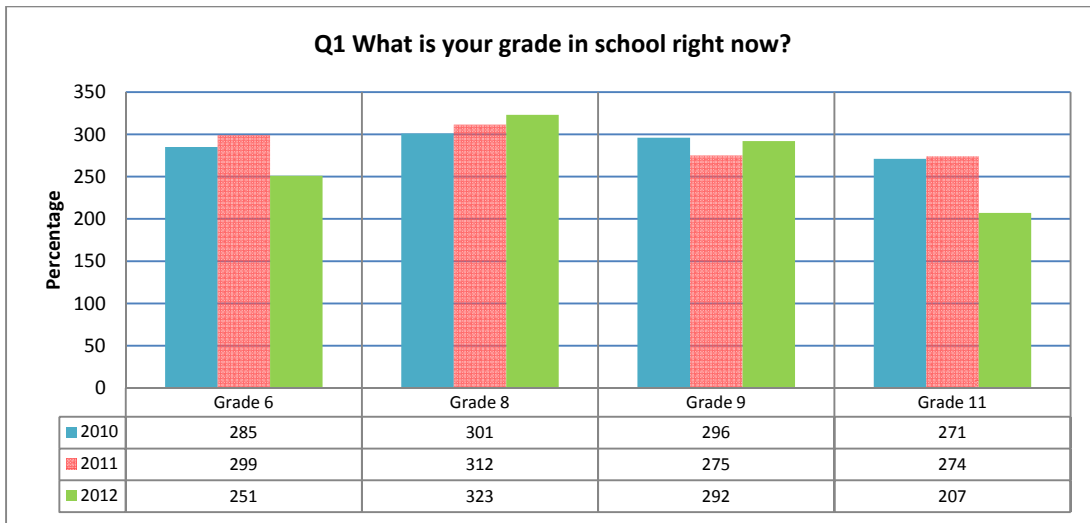

- 2012 data from students in grades 7, 10 and 12 will appear in individualized school reports. A total of 115 additional students in grades 7, 10 and 12 took the survey at Bethlehem Academy, and 22 additional students took the survey at Discovery Public school.

- Eight students (less than 1% of the total 2012 surveyed population) entered substance onset grades that exceeded their enrollment grade causing irreconcilable grade mismatches. These responses were deleted from the onset count used for the 2012 Faribault Student Survey and SAMHSA Reports. As a result of these deletions, some total percentage of responses will be slightly shy of 100%.

General Findings and Trends from Five Years of Collecting Student Survey Response Data

The following findings serve as broad but inconclusive indicators of potential trends. With five years of collected data, these indicators would suggest that measurable behavioral changes continue to occur, and that efforts made by the Rice County Family Services Collaborative and the Rice County Chemical Health Coalition are having a positive effect. Still, one needs to be aware of the drives and distractions that confront young people on a constant basis, and how these diversions might affect their responses. This survey does not attempt to measure or account for these.

Also to be considered is whether student responses might be skewed by the desire of some students to give responses that they perceive to be favored by adults, rather than completely candid. It is wise to constantly ask: *'Are students being completely honest with their answers or are they responding in a way to meet the expectations of their peers or supervising adults?'*

An example of a possible conflict appears in comparing the answers given by the 2012 eleventh graders in Q's 22 and 19 as displayed in the Trends section on page 49. Although the directional trend of both graphs appear very favorable, concern should be given to the data showing that nearly 54.6% of the current 11th graders state the belief in Q22 that "more than half" and/or "just about everybody" drinks alcohol, while 67.6% of the same group say in Q19 "I've never used alcohol." Some discussion on how it is possible for the data from 2012 to look so strikingly different from the data of 2008 is suggested.

The following bullet points will show some of the more notable changes from the four grade levels measured in 2012 compared with the responses from students in those same grade levels up to four years earlier. Since this survey measures grade levels and not cohort groups directly, these indicators show that some behaviors are indeed changing for subsequent generations of students as they pass through the grades being tracked by this survey, indicating that the program is having a positive impact. The continued collection of longitudinal survey data will allow for the tracking of these changes and the opportunity to verify through tangible evidence that these changes are indeed happening.

Tobacco: General Findings from the 2012 Survey compared to data collected from the 2008-2011 Surveys

1. Overall tobacco usage decreased from the previous year for both male and female students. (ref. SAMHSA p. 56)
2. Grade 11 continued an amazing five-year trend of reduced tobacco usage over the period from 2008 to 2012. (ref. Trends p. 48) and tobacco usage within the past 30 days (ref. SAMHSA p. 57)
3. Perception of harm from tobacco continued to rise for males overall, showing a four-year trend, but a drop in the perception of risk occurred from the composite female respondents. (ref. SAMHSA p. 60) Note: a change in wording may alter some of the comparisons for this item.
4. Perception of student tobacco usage was up slightly in grades 6 & 8, but uneven in grades 9 & 11. (ref. data p. 8)
5. The change in wording caused the perception of student tobacco usage as 'wrong' or 'very wrong' by other students to be high in all grades. Trends for this category will need to be compared to future years for accurate changes indicators. (ref. data p. 9)
6. Student perception of student tobacco usage by parents as being 'wrong' or 'very wrong' was also higher at all grades, possibly reflecting the wording changes referenced in #5 above. (ref. data p. 10)
7. The ability to obtain tobacco was considered less 'easy' at grades 9 and 11 (ref. data p. 11)

Alcohol: General Findings from the 2012 Survey compared to data collected from the 2008-2011 Surveys

1. Reported alcohol usage dropped for both male and female respondents in 2012. For the composite male student group, this constituted a four-year trend. (ref. SAMHSA p. 56) Note: a change in wording may alter some of the pre 2012 comparisons for this item.
2. Alcohol usage within the past 30 days dropped at each of the four grades surveyed, with the largest drops coming at grade 8 and 11. (ref. SAMHSA p. 57)
3. Student perception of 'a lot of harm' (great risk) or 'some harm' (moderate risk) from alcohol dropped from the previous year at all grades and for both genders. (ref. SAMHSA p. 60) Note: a change in wording may alter some of the pre 2012 comparisons for this item.
4. Student perception that 'just about everyone drinks alcohol' was down from the previous year at all grades except grade 8 where it remained the same as the previous year. (ref. data p. 16)
5. Student perception of students who 'think it's ok' for other students their age to drink alcohol show composite five-year trends of dropping at each grade level. (ref. Trends p. 50)
6. Student perception of parent disapproval of student alcohol use increased considerably in all grade levels and for both genders. (ref. SAMHSA p. 58) Note: a change in wording may alter some of the pre 2012 comparisons for this item.
7. Composite five-year trends show all grades claiming that it is less 'easy' for students their age to get alcohol. Only the 8th grade responses trended in the opposite direction in 2012. (ref. Trends p. 50)

Marijuana: General Findings from the 2012 Survey compared to data collected from the 2008-2011 Surveys

1. Marijuana usage 'within the past 30 days' in 2012 rose considerably in grade 9, fell a good deal in grade 11, and stayed at its previous levels in grades 6 & 8; likewise, the composite male and female groupings remained at their previous year levels. (ref. SAMHSA p. 58)
2. Fourteen percent of the 9th graders completing the required 2012 survey item said 'yes' to the question 'During the past 30 days have you used marijuana or hashish?' (ref. data p. 24) Based on the number of 9th grade respondents, that calculates to roughly 40 students.
3. Student perception of other student marijuana usage continues to trend upward at all grade levels. (ref. Trends p. 51)
4. Student perception of risk from using marijuana dropped at all four grade levels and both gender groups in 2012. (ref. SAMHSA p. 61) Note: a change in wording may alter some of the pre 2012 comparisons for this item.
5. Student perception of parent disapproval of student marijuana use was up from the previous year in all grades and both gender groups. (ref. SAMHSA p. 59)
6. Roughly 48% of 11th graders have consistently claimed for the past five years that it is 'easy' for students their age to get marijuana. (ref. Trends p. 51)

'Other Drugs' and Miscellaneous: General Findings

1. There is an overall, but small, general trend indicating that students think less other students are using the "other drugs" as listed in the survey. (ref. Trends p. 52)
2. Ninth grade students showed an increase in thinking that it was 'ok' for other students to use "other drugs" while 11th grade students registered a considerable drop in thinking that it was 'ok' for other students to use "other drugs." (ref. Trends p. 52)
3. Prior to this year, there was a general decline in the perception that it was 'easy' to obtain "other drugs" by 6th and 8th graders, while the 9th and 11th graders continued to remain steady at about 30% thinking that it is 'easy' to obtain "other drugs." (ref. Trends p. 53)
4. Slightly more 9th graders appear to be using prescription drugs that were not prescribed for them, but overall the usage remains relatively stable for the other grades. (ref. Trends p. 53)
5. The ability to get prescription drugs has remained relatively constant for the past five years with about 45% of the 9th and 11th graders believing that it is 'easy' to do so. (ref. Trends p. 54)
6. A majority of students in each grade felt that there were enough activities in school or out of school, for students their age in Faribault; but at each grade, the number of students answering 'no' to that question increased from the previous year. (ref. data p. 44)
7. Roughly 55% of the students stated that they participated in 2 or more different activities that involve adults as leaders or coaches. (ref. Trends p. 54)
8. Over 82% of the 1073 student respondents stated that it is 'somewhat' or 'very' important for students their age to volunteer in school or the community. (ref. data p. 46)
9. Over 40% of the students at each grade level state that it has been 'more than a year ago' or 'never' that their parents/guardians have talked to them about 'using tobacco, drinking alcohol or using drugs.' (ref. data p. 42)
10. More than 90% of all the students surveyed stated that there was 'at least one adult who had a positive influence on them.' (ref. data p. 45)

Notable Five-Year Trends from the 2008-2012 Surveys (only items where the wording has not changed for five years)

1. 11.8% drop in the use of tobacco by the 11th graders
2. 11.2% reduction in the belief that obtaining tobacco is 'easy' by the 8th graders
3. 10.3% decrease in 8th graders who say other students think it is 'ok' for students their age to drink alcohol
4. 17.6% decrease in 11th graders who say other students think it is 'ok' for students their age to drink alcohol
5. 11.3% decrease in 9th grade students stating alcohol was 'easy' to get.
6. 2.2% decrease in 8th graders and 3.2% decrease in 9th graders who say they have never used marijuana
7. 10.1% increase in the perception of 8th graders that more than half of the other students use marijuana
8. 3.9% increase in 9th grade students stating that marijuana is 'easy' to get
9. 14.8% reduction in the perception of 11th graders that more than half of the other students use 'other drugs'
10. 9.9% increase in 9th graders who say other students think it is 'ok' for students their age to use 'other drugs'
