## Raptor League

In a joint effort between parents, staff, and Shattuck's U16 boys' soccer team, the Raptor League had its first event recently. The "School Wipe-Down" was the group's first attempt to bring families and the community together to benefit the school.

Almost five months in the making, the Raptor League has been meeting with the CRSS Board, Administration, and Staff to discover how we can best serve our school. In this process, three areas of concentration have been identified for this group to take charge of; gathering and coordinating volunteers, providing assistance with fundraising activities, and helping to provide opportunities

for families and the community to connect with the school and with each other. These areas of focus also helped the group to form our mission statement; "The Cannon River STEM School Raptor League is committed to providing support to students and staff by fostering family and community involvement."

We are currently meeting on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month at 7:00 pm in the school cafeteria to finish up the Raptor League bylaws. ## The Lottery is Coming!

As you all know, Cannon River STEM School limits class size. We use a lottery system as defined in state law to fill available openings in sections for next year. This year's lottery is on March 14<sup>th</sup>, and applications for inclusion in the lottery must be received at the office on Tuesday, March 12<sup>th</sup> by 4:00 pm. A few things to remember about the lottery:

- Students already enrolled and attending CRSS are automatically enrolled into the next grade. So if you have a child in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade now, we will automatically enroll him/her into 3<sup>rd</sup> grade at the start of the lottery. The first week of March, we will distribute forms to assess whether you plan on returning next year so that we can determine how many slots may be available for the lottery. If we don't hear back from you, we assume your child will continue at CRSS
- Siblings of currently enrolled students have preference in the lottery. After existing students are enrolled for the next year, any siblings of those students are enrolled in existing slots, or placed first on the waiting list. If there are more siblings than available slots, a sibling lottery precedes the general lottery to place siblings in order. If your enrolled child has a sibling you would like enrolled in CRSS next year, please submit an application as soon as possible, but definitely before 4:00 pm on March 12th!
- The general lottery then pulls and places applications in order for each grade, starting with 8<sup>th</sup> grade and working down by grade level to kindergarten.
- On the day of the lottery, the previous year's waiting list expires, and a new waiting list is created through the lottery process.

We could use your help! Encourage interested families to submit an application to enter the lottery prior to the March 12<sup>th</sup> deadline. Remember that our class size increases to 22 at grade 4, so we will have at least 4 openings in 4<sup>th</sup> grade next year! Parents of current students provide our best, and most compelling marketing!
