Purpose

The Title 1 teacher promotes and develops successful reading instruction for students and performs related duties in accordance with CRSS policies. The teacher also maintains a cooperative attitude with staff, parents, and students.

The Title 1 teacher is responsible for group and individual instruction of reading for students who meet state and federal guidelines. The Title 1 teacher may supervise and develop lessons for paraprofessionals, and measures student progress. The Title I teacher also will oversee the District Title I program and compliance.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Coordinate and develop the Title I program in the school based on guidelines established by the District and state and federal governments
- Demonstrate knowledge of and ability to use research-based principles of effective instruction
- Implement a variety of assessment instruments to determine eligibility and instructional needs of students in reading
- Organize instruction using learning objectives with clearly defined student outcomes
- Provide a variety of instructional techniques and methods that are appropriate to individual student abilities and promote high levels of achievement
- Monitor student learning and pace instruction accordingly
- Maintain a cooperative relationship with administration, staff, students, and parents
- Keep parents and teachers informed through written and oral communication
- Maintain appropriate records of student performance
- Plan activities for Title I parents' involvement in the school

Required Education, License, Experience and Skills

- Bachelor's degree of related subject from accredited university.
- Valid MN teaching license (K-6 Elementary Education).
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with parents, students, teachers, staff, administrators, agency personnel and others.

- Must be self-motivated, self-directed, collaborative and flexible.
- Must clear pre-employment background check and substance abuse screening.

Desirable Qualifications

- ELL certification and/or ASL proficiency.
- Project based or environmental education teaching experience.

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to operate a computer, copier, printer, fax machine and phone.
- Must be able to stand, walk, navigate rugged terrain, reach with arms and hands, balance, stoop, sit on the floor and kneel.

Benefits

- This is a full-time regular school year position that is eligible for the Cannon River STEM School's benefit program. The benefit program includes health, dental and life insurance, long term care, long term disability, TRA retirement program and PTO.
