The first part of each grade level supply list is Community Supplies – these supplies do not need to be labeled and will be used by all members of the classroom or school community. The second part of each list is for Personal Supplies – these supplies should be labeled. **Reusing supplies from previous years is a great way to reduce the cost of the lists and to remind students to practice Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.**

<b>All grades provide:</b> 1 clean set of extra clothes - The extra set of clothes is requested for those times when students get muddy or wet.		

Outdoor gear is essential for success at Cannon River STEM School. Raingear for the fall and spring should include some sort of raincoat/poncho and shoes/mud boots that can get wet. Winter gear includes boots, snowpants, coat, hat and gloves/mittens. All students K-8 will be spending time outdoors throughout the week and are expected to have this clothing (gear) on hand in order to complete the learning objectives of the lesson.

### **A few extra notes 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grades:**

- For students in Grades 6-8 the students will need gym shoes one trimester of the school year. That trimester these shoes should be able to stay at school.
- If possible the container of disinfecting wipes should be unscented, lemon, or citrus for use in the classroom and computer lab spaces. The specific scents are requested due to some allergy requirements.
- Backpacks with wheels do not fit in the middle school lockers.
- It would be good to keep an extra shirt, pair of pants and socks in the locker. Students can expect to get wet from time to time and having an extra set of clothes in the back pack really makes for a more comfortable day.
- Plain #2 pencils are on the lists. The decorated pencils have a plastic coating that does not sharpen well and are usually more expensive so the plain pencils are better.
- When choosing dry erase markers if the low odor variety are available that would be preferred since 22 smelly markers in a classroom can be pretty overwhelming.
- Again, even and especially in grades 6 – 8 outdoor gear is essential for success at Cannon River STEM School. Raingear for the fall and spring should include some sort of raincoat/poncho and shoes/mud boots that can get wet. Winter gear includes boots, snowpants, coat, hat and gloves/mittens. All students K-8 will be spending time outdoors throughout the week and are expected to have this clothing (gear) on hand in order to complete the learning objectives of the lesson.
